



The telephone box at Bewdley was designed to boost trade for the post office, with a post box and stamp dispensers built into its rear. These were never common and we believe that only 6 survive. This example was aquired and erected at the buffet end of Platform 1 when the station was preserved complete with working telephone. However, this feature was disconnected after continued vandalism and the box was moved whole to its new location when the offices were extended. The structure can be illuminated for special events if required.
