



In 1896 a cast iron mens urinal was built at the south end of the island platform. This stood until just before the preservationists took over when it was demolished. The current structure came from Melrose station on the closed Waverley Route in Scotland. This was erected at Bewdley in 1977 and was opened by the Mayor of Bewdley. Sadly, however the toilets were closed in 1998 due to the absence of handwashing facilities and adequate sewers.
