



A view from the bridge, facing north. Platform 1 on the left is shorter than the island platforms. The latter were extended in 1878 to serve the longer trains expected upon the opening of the Kidderminster line. Platform 1 however was left at its original length and was then mainly used for the trains to Tenbury. The Severn Valley is seen continuing in the distance. The railway leaves Bewdley on the east side of the river, but crosses it at Arley using Victoria Bridge and then runs on the Western valley wall to Bridgnorth
