



Bewdley South Signal Box is a mirror image of North Signal Box and is located on the east side of the line rather than the west. Unlike North Box however, the structure is dug into a cutting side, rather than being perched on top of an embankment. Uniquely on the SVR, this signal box does not give any tokens to a train passing in either direction. The section between the two Bewdley Signal Boxes is worked on the main line absolute block system, whilst trains to Kidderminster use the acceptance lever principle, which is worked by pulling a lever at both ends of the section.
