During its long history, Bewdley station has been lit by a wide variety of different lamp designs. Originally cuboidal lamp heads were fitted to cast iron posts and these were either gas or oil lit. This system remained although the lamp head design probably varied until the 1950s when modern electric lamps on twin headed concrete posts replaced them. The early preservationists replaced these, using British railways lamp heads (Converted to electricity) on reclaimed cast iron posts. Most of the posts were of GWR origin, however some which can be seen on Platform 2 are of LMS origin and are differently shaped (The post shown is GWR). The current Windsor Lamp heads were fitted in 2001/2 and are replicas of those used by the GWR.
